POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Hawkers and Peddlers

M.G.L. 101:3. "...upon the payment of a fee, as determined annually by the commissioner of administration under the provision of section three B of chapter seven, the director shall issue to him (or her -- the vendor) a state license authorizing him (or her) to do business as a transient vendor, subject to such local rules and regulations as may be made in a city by the mayor and city council and in a town by the selectmen." Last amended and approved 1985.

License to Carry a Pistol.

801 CMR 4.00 Firearms Section Rates

(4) License to carry firearms \$100.00

Firearm Identification Card

M.G.L. 140:129B. "The fee for an application and card shall be two dollars which shall be payable to the licensing authority and shall not be prorated or refunded in case of revocation or denial." last amended and approved 1989.

Sale of Firearms

M.G.L. 140:122. "The chief of police or the board or officer having control of the police in a city or town, or persons authorized by them, may, after an investigation, grant a license to any person... to sell, rent or lease firearms, rifles, shotguns or machine guns, or to be in business as a gunsmith. ... The fee for any license issued under this section shall be set by, and payable in, a manner prescribed by the authorities empowered to issue said license, but said fee shall not exceed twenty dollars per year." Last amended and approved 1959.

License to Sell Ammunition

M.G.L. 140:122B. "The fee for a license to sell ammunition shall be set by a licensing authority, but in no event shall any such fee be greater than twenty-five dollars." Last amended and approved 1989.

Bicycle License

M.G.L. 85:11A. Maximum fee of \$2.50.

Police Report

The fee structure for copies of police reports is defined in Chapter 477 of the Acts of 1982 for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts

M.G.L. 66:1 Delegates the supervisor of public records the authority to establish fees and other regulations to administer public record law.
